

### Works Description:

The type of work involved includes the removal of failed sections of pavement, subsequent strengthening of these sections and resurfacing with bituminous macadam.

Works also include storm water drainage, new footpaths and kerbs, Central Islands, Bridge rehabilitation works including replacement of existing Parapet, installation of a new Vehicle Restraint System, tree surgery, traffic signs and road markings and traffic management.

## N20 Mallow Southern Approach Overlay Scheme:

### ***N20 Blackrock Bridge Rehabilitation***

Works are on the western bridge parapet are now complete and the contractor will commence works on the eastern bridge parapet on Monday the 02<sup>nd</sup> of November with the erection of a temporary edge protection system. Pedestrian movement will be maintained whilst these works are being erected however the footpath will be closed to all through traffic from Monday ***the 09<sup>th</sup> of November*** in order to safely facilitate the construction works.

The footpath will be reopened during the Christmas holidays for a two-week period and will subsequently be closed from the 04<sup>th</sup> of January 2021 until the works on the eastern bridge parapet and eastern carriageway are complete. This includes re-grouting, waterproofing of the bridge deck and subsequent re-surfacing. It is anticipated that the footpath will be re-opened at the end of April 2021.

We acknowledge that the footpath is a popular walking route and its temporary closure will be an inconvenience to the people of Mallow, however in order for it to be maintained during construction would require the N20 to be reduced to one lane. Given the traffic volumes on the N20 this approach is not desirable. We would appreciate your understanding of what are necessary restrictions and we will endeavor to expedite the construction times to return the footpath as soon as possible.

### ***Traffic Management:***

A stop / go system will be in operation intermittently for certain work activities, otherwise it is envisaged that two-way traffic will be maintained.

Substantial completion of the overlay and bridge rehabilitation schemes is anticipated by May 2021. This is based on no further Covid 19 restrictions or other constraints, and therefore may be subject to change
